GLOSSARY: TAPESTRY WALL HANGINGS AND PRINTED LINEN PANELS	
PLP	<i>Printed Linen Panel</i> refers to designs that ordered as lengths of printed fabric to be made up to your own specification. (cf. Wall hanging below.)
TWH	<i>Tapestry Wall Hanging</i> refers to a finished product that is ready to be installed; it is lined and interlined, weighted and fitted with a Velcro strip along the top edge.
PA	<i>Print Allowances</i> refer to printed seaming allowance in both the vertical and in the lateral dimensions.
SA	The <i>Seaming Allowance</i> refers to the PA on the sides of each drop – usually 1-2 cm on each side. In some cases, the SA on the external edges of the first and last drops will be wider to provide additional tolerance.
MB	<i>Mirror Bleed</i> is a specific type of PA created by mirroring the outer sections of a design.

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
